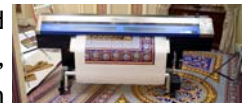
Zip-Change Track

The XC 540 vs. the XC 540MT

The difference between the XC 540 and XC 540MT is that the XC-540MT has been optimized for use with Roland's ECO SOL MAX metallic silver ink. The XC 540 is available in a six color configuration (CMYKLcLm) or five (CMYK + White). The XC 540MT also has two optional configurations: CMYK + Metallic Silver + White (CMYK+MT+W) or CMYK+W+W which offers the brightest white text and graphics. Metallic Silver ECO-SOL MAX ink produces vibrant silver text and graphics previously impossible with any inkjet printer. It can also be combined with CMYK to create an entire spectrum of metallic hues including gold, bronze and a host of pearlescent colors.

It features an advanced Job Log that allows exporting of job data to Microsoft Excel supported file formats.
